PART 1 GENERAL

- Purpose** 1. The CBE recognizes that smoking by students, Staff and other persons using CBE facilities is not conducive to maintaining a healthy environment. Further, the CBE is aware of the need to set a positive and healthy example for students.
- Definitions** 2. In this Regulation:
- 1) **“Staff”** means a person who performs a service for the CBE:
 - a. as an employee (a person who is employed in a permanent or temporary capacity by the CBE);
 - b. as a contractor (a person, company or organization external to the CBE who is hired to provide services); or
 - c. in an agency relationship.
- Communication** 3. All facilities and property owned and operated by the CBE are smoke-free environments. This includes parking lots, playgrounds, fields and CBE-owned or leased vehicles.
- Application** 4. This Regulation applies to all users of CBE facilities and property, including students and Staff.
