



A Public Engagement session was held at the Area III Office on April 19, 2016, to provide information on schools impacted by new school openings and to collect feedback on the opportunities for using additional space in schools to best meet the learning needs of students, families, and the community. Three people attended this engagement and were asked to provide feedback on opportunities developed in collaboration with system principals.

Language and Non-Language Alternative Programs:

- Punjabi language alternative program would be good in Area III
- Add science program in Area III (+1+1 additional support)
- High demand for TLC in Area III
- TLC – Traditional Learning
 - We have lots of demand for TLC Program in Area III. Lots of Parents end up enrolling their kids/children in regular program because they cannot make it in the Lottery system. Others are happy because they will make it to lottery system. Right now, TLC is only available k to 9. In my personal view it should be available for K-12. New mid and high schools in Saddleridge should have TLC program available, it is high in demand here AND we have lesser school available.
