# Acknowledging the land where we gather







## **Three Year School Capital Plan**

- Board of Trustees approves the Three Year School Capital Plan at a public meeting in March for submission to government by April 1 each year.
- Provincial capital funding announcements take place in February/March based upon the previous year's submission.
- The design and construction of projects is coordinated in cooperation with Alberta Infrastructure.







#### Three Year School Capital Plan – New Schools

Data driven decision-making to support a fair and equitable process for all communities.

- City of Calgary civic census
- Canada Revenue Agency aggregated age data
- School enrolment
- School bus transportation times
- City of Calgary Suburban Residential Growth
- Calgary & Region Economic Outlook





#### Three Year School Capital Plan – New Schools

- Eligibility population threshold
- Accommodation options can students be accommodated at an existing school
- Site availability and readiness is there a suitable site available for a new school and is it ready for construction to commence

#### High Schools

- Availability of a site to construct a high school
- High school utilization rates
- Student enrolment
- Community demographics





#### Three Year School Capital Plan – Major Modernizations

- Provide for the renovation of whole or part of a school building and will address physical obsolescence and/or improve functionality.
- Major modernizations on the capital plan can include elementary, middle/junior and high schools.

Considerations include:

- Programming requirements
- Five year projected school enrollment
- Quality of site location to serve students
- Ability to upgrade teaching/learning environment
- Minimize costs to operate and maintain the facility
