As you are aware, Lord Beaverbrook High School is scheduled to undergo a significant modernization that will result in new facilities for many of our career and technology courses.

Lord Beaverbrook High School was open in 1968 and is a tremendous facility for students. While there have been many updates to the facility over the years, this modernization will be a significant improvement to the school. We are eagerly awaiting the start of this project and know that our current and future students will benefit greatly from this work.

With the hiring of a project manager and contractor, the project is nearing the construction phase. Some preliminary work has begun to re-locate two of our computer labs from the main floor to the second floor. There will be five phases to construction spread over a two and a half year period. Phase One is scheduled to begin early in the new year 2017.
