



FAQ | Coventry/Country Hills Village School Construction Project

Where can I find more information on the new school construction project?

Each new school construction project has a webpage that is updated monthly or when there is important information to share. For updates and announcements please check www.cbe.ab.ca/newschools.

Can I sign up for an email list to receive announcements/news about the new school?

Important information will be shared via SchoolMessenger (email) with parents who have children in the existing designated schools for this community. Otherwise, you can find general updates and information on the webpage www.cbe.ab.ca/newschools. Messages sent through SchoolMessenger will also be posted on the webpage for anyone who is interested in this project and does not have a child in a designated school.

How are plans for the new school developed and approved?

Alberta Infrastructure (AI) is managing the construction of the new school in Coventry Hills/Country Hills Village. AI is working with the CBE and the City of Calgary in conjunction with the architect to determine site configurations. Site configurations are approved by the City of Calgary during the Development Permit process.

When will the new school in my community open?

An opening date has not been selected for the new school in your community. Once the anticipated opening date is determined it will be posted on the project webpage.

What grades will be offered in the new school?

The new school will be a second elementary school for your community. The opening of this school will provide space to accommodate all regular program kindergarten to Grade 9 students in one of the three schools. As we get closer to the opening date, we will be reviewing enrolment at the existing two schools as well as projections for community growth to determine the grade configuration for the new school.

What will the attendance area be for the new school?

The attendance area will be determined closer to when the school opens. Another open house will be held to share information on the attendance area, the walk zone and the grade configuration.

Why is our community getting a second elementary school?

When determining if a community needs a school, the CBE considers all of the pre-school children and all of the current students in that community who are enrolled in CBE schools, including students who may be attending alternative programs that are located in other communities. Why was this site chosen for the new school?

The Municipal Government Act requires 10 per cent of new development area to be designated for amenities: parks; public space; community association sites and school sites. At the initial stage of community development, the developer offers land parcels for schools. CBE and Calgary Catholic School Board work with City planning to select from the offered sites in general locations for future schools.
