H.W. Riley School

In 2009 H.W. Riley School was formally closed by the Calgary Board of Education.

From 2010-2012 the Area III administrative offices were located at the school. Since September 2012 the school has been empty.

Currently, the Government of Alberta is considering H.W. Riley School be utilized as a possible location for an Aboriginal Learning Centre.

A stand-alone site for our Aboriginal program has been a priority on the CBE's Capital Plan since 2005-2006 and in 2013 Alberta Education has made establishment of an Aboriginal Learning Centre a priority.

Over the next several months the CBE and the Government of Alberta will be talking with stakeholders to determine how H.W. Riley School might be developed to support the Aboriginal community in Calgary.
