

JUBE SCHOOL

Twenty-five Junior High students from Our Lady of the Assumption came to the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium to explore their yearlong inquiry of "CHOOSE YOUR PATH".

Each morning, for 5 days, students worked alongside visual artist, Brianna Strong, exploring their curiosity and excitement around the act of discovery through visual storytelling. Through layers, patterns and shadow work, students examined how their choices can have an impact on the bigger picture. Students discovered that although they did not know the end result, there was a process. Out of this exploration the hashtag, #trusttheprocessyyc was created.

Students had the opportunity to interview experts at the Jubilee as well as take part in lighting, stage combat, backstage tours, knots and rigging workshops.

The mural you see was created to connect to the YYC Instagrammable Wall movement. Exploration of how we interact in social spaces, how we take up space and how our space affects others are all underling themes.
