Fuel for School is a program designed to provide hungry Calgary Board of Education (CBE) elementary students with a nutritious breakfast prior to starting their studies each day. The aim of the program is to reduce the emotional stress, health risks and negative academic efforts of hunger and poor nutrition for elementary-aged students. Fuel for School works with a variety of nutrition partners, corporate and private donors to provide this service at no cost to the children. Each year over 100,000 breakfasts are served in the CBE breakfast programs. Over 30,000 of those served are in Fuel for school programs. Currently there are 9 elementary schools involved in the Fuel for School program. Each school serve between 10 and 25 breakfasts each day.

In addition to supports for food, an important component of this program is the CBE breakfast supervisor. The consistency of a caring, supportive individual greatly enhances the personal experience for each student in the breakfast program. The average cost to run the Fuel for School Program is approximately \$16,000 per year.

The Calgary Board of Education currently relies on donations from various organizations and donors to support the Fuel for School breakfast programs.
