### CBE Board of Trustees asks for public input on byelection

CALGARY – It is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees to decide whether or not to hold a byelection to address the vacant seat for wards 11 and 13 since the resignation of Sheila Taylor as trustee at the Calgary Board of Education (CBE) in October.

The Board is now asking for input from the public prior to making this decision. An online survey has been created and is available on the front page of the CBE website: [www.cbe.ab.ca](http://www.cbe.ab.ca).

Chair of the Board of Trustees Joy Bowen-Eyre says, "It's important that the public have a voice in this decision and that's why the Board has created this survey. We're encouraging everyone to take a few minutes to share their thoughts with us. We want to hear from as many people as possible."

The survey closes on Monday, Nov. 24, 2014.
