
We live 3km from the newly constructed Middle School. As much as I believe that exercise is a must for all of us, I am concerned with the distance my child may need to walk in sub zero temperature and inclement weather. As both my wife and I work at start times that are earlier than school usually starts, this will put undue strain on our employment situation during periods when the weather is such that it is not feasible to walk the 3km to school.

My second issue is that the safety and security of our children is of primary importance to us. Although rare, there are greater opportunities for child/teen predators to approach my child over a 3 km distance. There have been reports of children being approached in our area over the past 10 years and I am just not comfortable with my child walking to her school.

Q4: Is there anything else we need to consider regarding walk zones as we move forward?

We live in location where there appears to be a great number of children that will either be going to the West Springs/Cougar Ridge Middle School, or will be attending in the next couple of years. I'm sure you have looked at the age demographics for the area, but if not, I would urge you to take a good look at this to help justify a change in transportation needs for our area that is currently outside of the busing area.

Thank you for your consideration of my rational for moving West Springs Place out of the "Walking Zone" and to prove bus transportation.
