Inform | Lakeshore School Opening in Auburn Bay

Re: Change to opening school date and additional school information.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) is pleased to be opening a new middle school in Auburn Bay, Lakeshore School. The new school will accommodate Grades 5 to 9 in the 2022-23 school year and Grades 6 to 9 in the 2023-24 school year and beyond.

Due to construction delays affected by many factors such as adverse weather and supply chain challenges, Lakeshore School will not be ready to welcome students on Sept.1. We are working closely with Alberta Infrastructure and will continue to support the construction process to ensure the school is complete and opened as soon as possible.

We are now expecting the school's opening to be delayed a few weeks into the beginning of the school year. At this time, we cannot communicate a definitive opening date. We will provide another update prior to the start of the 2022-23 school year regarding the delay and let you know as soon as a date is confirmed.

We have developed a plan to support students during this construction delay as outlined below. Should there be any changes to the expected timeline or contingency plans, you will be informed as soon as possible.

If the new school opening is delayed, where will students go in the fall?

We are organizing a 'school within a school' model to accommodate students during this construction delay. We use this model when a school's opening is delayed after a new school year has started. Students residing in the communities of Auburn Bay and Mahogany who are designated to Lakeshore School will attend the following schools according to their Grade until the school's construction is complete:

School Name	Grades
Riverbend School	Grade 5
Sherwood School	Grade 6
Nickle School	Grade 7 to 9

The 'school within a school' model helps make the transition easier by aiming to keep students together with their teachers allowing them to build relationships and make the transition to the new school with fewer disruptions to learning.

Principals of Lakeshore, Riverbend, Sherwood and Nickle Schools will work closely together to facilitate a smooth beginning to the 2022-23 school year and a successful transition to the new Lakeshore School.

Which communities are designated to attend Lakeshore School?

Please see the attached attendance area map for Lakeshore School.

Do I need to register my child?

If your student is registered for Lakeshore School, there is no action required from you. CBE Administration will ensure eligible students are transferred to their designated schools outlined above while the contingency plan is in place and back to Lakeshore School once it opens.

Please note that the new school will only be able to accommodate students living within the designated area. Out-of-attendance area students will not be accepted for the new Lakeshore School.

Who is the new school Principal?

Ian Fero is the principal of Lakeshore School. He will continue to work with the existing and new school communities, parents and students to develop a school opening transition plan.

Can my child take the school bus?

Transportation services will be provided to students who live in the designated area for Lakeshore School. Students will be automatically added to a route according to the school-in-school location, and no further action is required. Since we expect a few weeks delay in the new school opening, transportation fees will not be charged.

Please note that transportation times will vary for each school due to Nickle School, Sherwood School and Riverbend School's varying bell times.

Nickle School: 8:05 am - 2:40 pm Riverbend School: 8:00 am - 2:35 pm Sherwood School: 8:10 am - 2:50 p

The opening of this school is exciting for the Auburn Bay community, allowing middle school-aged students to attend school closer to home. We look forward to working with you as we welcome students to their new school.
